Tournament Rules

- 1. Umpire/Tournament Directors decisions are final.
- 2. Tournament is considered to be D-League Co-Ed ASA rules.
 - a. Walking a Male If a male is walked and the following batter is female, the female batter may take the walk.
 - b. Strike-Outs For every MALE strike-out there will be a \$ 5.00 charge. All funds raised will go to ALL athletic programs at Vermilion Catholic.
 - c. Home Runs Batters may only tag first base. All runners on base must run the remaining bases.
 - d. Home Runs Unlimited home runs \$ 5.00 per home run. Max of 7 homeruns per inning.
- 3. Teams will be Co-Ed. There must be a minimum of 10 players, 3 of which are female.
- 4. Only Vermilion Catholic High School Alumni and their spouses are allowed to play (no children, dependents, etc.) If a non-alumni spouse plays, the alumni spouse must begin at the same time, play defense and be listed in the batting order for at least the one inning. Alumni spouse and non-alumni spouse must be in the dugout/dugout area for that entire game.
- 5. Teams may use Vermilion Catholic alumni from classes two years prior and two years after their graduating classes.
- 6. Teams are required to have a minimum of 3 females playing the field at all times. The pitcher or catcher must be female.
- 7. Every hitter starts with a 1 to 1 count (1ball, 1 strike) and they have a courtesy foul. A courtesy foul means that the player starts with a 1 and 1 count; if he fouls off a ball, the player has two strikes the hitter will have a courtesy foul. Game speed-up rules if necessary will be a 1 pitch per at bat will apply to Sunday only.
- 8. Games will run 50 minutes. The inning in progress will be finished
- 9. The order of batting remains the same for each inning. The batting order continues where it left off at the end of the last inning. The normal Co-Ed batting order will alternate male and female batters. Men cannot bat back to back, but women can.
- 10. If the eligibility of a player is questioned (i.e., alumni status, proof of marriage/common law marriage) proof of identification and eligibility must be immediately presented to play (such as valid driver's license with same address as the spouse).
- 11. There will be a \$ 100.00 non-refundable charge paid at the beginning of a formal protest, and then both playing teams roster will be verified. Any team involved in a protest found to have an illegal player, will be automatically eliminated from the tournament and games forfeited. The final decision will rest upon the Tournament Directors.
- 12. Players are playing at their own risk; Vermilion Catholic High School and Vermilion Catholic Booster Club is not responsible for injuries or accidents that occur during the Tournament.

- 13. Incrediball will be used in tournament play and will be provided by the Tournament sponsors on the day of the event and must bear the mark for that particular event. They must also be returned at the end of tournament play.
- 14. Foul or vulgar language will not be tolerated in the stands or on the fields of play. It is the intent of VC Booster Club to maintain a family type of atmosphere for all to enjoy. Loud obscene language is ground for removal from the tournament and the park.
- 15. No specific reason is required to disqualify a Team that in any way circumvents the intent of the Tournament Directors and/or the Tournament Rules. We expect each class to support the Tournament and the intent of the rules. With Team and Player cooperation, we do not expect to have issues with the rosters and sportsmanship. If a class has any concern or issue with Tournament Rules and policies, they are expected to declare, in writing and in advance, any and all concerns or requests to the Tournament Committee VC Booster Club, 425 Park Avenue, Abbeville, LA 70510. All concerns and request will be brought to the Tournament Committee. Failure to request/obtain specific written approval is cause for disqualification. At any time before or during the tournament, the Tournament Directors have the discretion to make the final calls on rule amendments due to fairness and safety of all participants in the event.

NOTICE TO PLAYERS, SPONSORS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS

Every effort is made to prepare these ball fields properly. However due to normal play and continuous use, the conditions may become less than ideal. Bases or home plates may become dislodged or holes around home plate or bases may occur. If you observe any of these conditions or any other dangerous conditions contact the tournament directors immediately. Stop the game until repairs can be made to insure safety. Be aware that you are participating in athletic competition and injuries can and do occur. Vermilion Catholic High School, Vermilion Catholic Booster Club assume no responsibility for injuries.
