- If work or family obligations interfere with your **mandated two-hour shift(s)** for May Festival, you may provide an adult replacement (at least twenty-one years of age) or you will be assessed a fee of **\$500.00 per student**. This fee must be paid prior to final exams.

May Festival worker schedules will be assigned following the Christmas holidays. We will give parents an opportunity to request to work a particular day of the festival, rather than the other, prior to assigning the work schedule. Every attempt will be made to honor requests that are received.

We want all of our parents to participate in the Mount Carmel/Vermilion Catholic family event. The May Festival is something our whole family and community look forward to every year. It cannot be a success without the participation of every family.
