- Grades 9-12: essay

Interested students must complete:

- 1) The attached application form
- 2) Verification letter of good standings
- 3) One letter of recommendation from an individual not related to the applicant
- 4) A handwritten letter (6-8th) or an essay (9-12th)
- **Final award recipients must provide evidence of enrollment in the Catholic academic institution to which they will be attending. The scholarship funds will be credited directly to the school on the behalf of the recipient(s).
