Scholarship Offered in Memory of: Mr. Ernie and Mrs. Matsy Guidry

This scholarship is meant for those current or prospective students who demonstrate the Spirit of VC! The spirit of VC is defined as those who demonstrate a sense of care for others, a love of Christ, and a distinct desire to be an active part of the VC community. Scholarship in the classroom and financial need are considered prerequisites.

This scholarship honors the memory of Mr. Ernie and Mrs. Matsy Guidry who both demonstrated these Spirit of VC attributes. Mr. Ernie and Mrs. Matsy were actively involved while students at Mount Carmel. Mr. Ernie was a 1955 graduate of Mount Carmel High School and a member of the “Iron Dozen” football team. In life he served his country and his community and was an avid supporter of Catholic education. Mrs. Matsy was a proud graduate from Mt Carmel High School in 1956 and was chosen as Homecoming Queen. She attended SLI. She married the love of her life, Ernie Guidry, in 1958 and together had 5 children, 22 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren. She created a home that reflected God’s love and valued all who entered. Together they were devoted to marriage, family, and faith, their life of Christian love was a witness to all.

It is the utmost intention that this scholarship gives others the same opportunity to engage in a meaningful Catholic education that will shape their lives through these same experiences.

Number of Scholarships Offered Each Year:

Amount of Each Individual Scholarship Offered:

\$2,000 per year for K-8 and \$2,500 per year for 9-12.

Renewal Guidelines:

The Spirit of VC Scholarship Award recipients must provide proof of continued financial need as well as continued demonstration of a sense of care for others, a love of Christ, and a distinct desire to be an active part of the VC community.

First Time Application Guidelines:

1. Spirit of VC Demonstration - letter or essay providing evidence of alignment with sense of care, love of Christ and desire to be part of the VC community
 - a. K-5th grade - a letter from the parents to the selection committee expressing their personal desire for Catholic education for their child and what it means to their family.
 - b. 6th - 12th grade - a one to two page essay on "What a VC Education Means to Me"
2. Financial Need - All families wishing to be considered must submit an application through the FACTS portal by March 15, 2025.
