- **How does the cost of tuition compare to the cost of daycare?**
 - We offer easy and affordable 10-month payment plans for tuition and fees. PreK3-5th grade is only \$614 for 10 months.
- **What time does school begin and dismiss?**
 - We take students in from 7:00 am - 7:35 am and dismissal is at 2:45 pm.
- **Is there after-school care available?**
 - Our daily Carmel Care program is available on campus until 5:30 pm.
- **What is the reading curriculum for K through 5th?**
