# HAVE YOU THOUGHT ABOUT CATHOLIC EDUCATION?

- **What is the cost of tuition?**
  - We offer easy and affordable 10-month payment plans for tuition and fees. PreK3-5th grade is \$564, 6th-8th is \$664, and 9th-12th is \$815 for 10 months.
- **What time does school begin and dismiss?**
  - We take students in from 7:00 am - 7:35 am and dismissal is at 2:45 pm.
- **Is there after-school care available?**
  - Our daily Carmel Care program is available on campus until 5:30 pm.
- **What are the athletic programs that are offered at VC?**
  - The athletic programs begin in 6th grade. Baseball, bowling, basketball, soccer, cheer, cross country, dance team, football, powerlifting, golf, softball, tennis, track and field, and volleyball.
- **What is VC's average class size and student/teacher ratio?**
  - VC has an average class size of 15 and a 12:1 student/teacher ratio.
- **Are all students 1:1 in technology?**
  - Yes, all students have a Chromebook.
- **What is STEAM lab?**
  - Our STEAM enrichment program is designed to explore the fields of science, technology, engineering, arts, and math for PreK3-12th grade students. Classes are hands-on and interactive and go beyond the traditional subjects taught in school, allowing students to explore a variety of exciting and engaging topics.
- **What makes Catholic education unique with Theology/Religion taught throughout the day?**
  - In addition to a comprehensive Theology curriculum outlined by the US College of Catholic Bishops, VC believes in educating the whole child - socially, emotionally, physically, intellectually, and spiritually - through the lens of faith and seeks to incorporate this into everything we do. It is also the mission of each teacher on our campus to prayerfully approach their particular course content in the light of the Gospel of Christ.
