



# Privacy Guides for TikTok

TikTok is primarily a mobile or tablet app, though you can log in on a browser on a computer. The following steps are for a smartphone or tablet.

1. Open TikTok and log in to your child's account.
2. Select the **Profile icon** in the lower right-hand corner.
3. Select the **☰** button in the upper right-hand corner, then select **Settings and privacy** in the pop-up menu.
4. Tap on **Privacy**. Here you can set their account to **Private**, toggle the **Activity status**, and adjust how others interact with your child through comments, mentions, direct messages, etc.
5. Go back to **Settings and privacy**. Tap **Security & permissions**. We recommend setting **2-step verification** for more enhanced security from potential hackers or any unauthorized access.
6. Return to **Settings and Privacy** and select **Content Preferences**. This menu allows you to filter specific keywords and turn on **Restricted Mode**, which limits the likelihood of an inappropriate video appearing in your child's **For You Page**.
7. Return to **Settings and Privacy** and select **Screen Time**. Here you can adjust screen time settings.
8. Scroll down and tap on the **Family Pairing** option. If you have a TikTok account, you can link to your child's account to review their activity, limit who can contact them, and manage their privacy and safety settings.
