Frequently Asked Questions

- Should I pack a lunch?
 - The applicant can bring a lunch from home or he/she can eat in the cafeteria
- What does the student shadow wear?
 - Any school appropriate clothes are allowed
- Where is carline drop off?
 - 1st-8th dropoff line is in the front of Lower Campus. You can turn by the tennis courts and follow the road all the way around the playground.
 - 9th-12 dropoff line is in the front of Upper Campus. You can turn into the Upper Campus parking lot and go in front of the Upper Campus front doors.
- Does the student shadow need to bring any school supplies or backpack?
 - It is not needed, but if it makes him/her more comfortable then it is definitely allowed. A book is encouraged.
- What does the Admissions interview consist of?
 - Parents/guardians and the applicant will meet with members of the Admissions Committee to discuss how the applicant's day went. This is a time for everyone to meet and discuss how Vermilion Catholic can help make the applicant successful.
