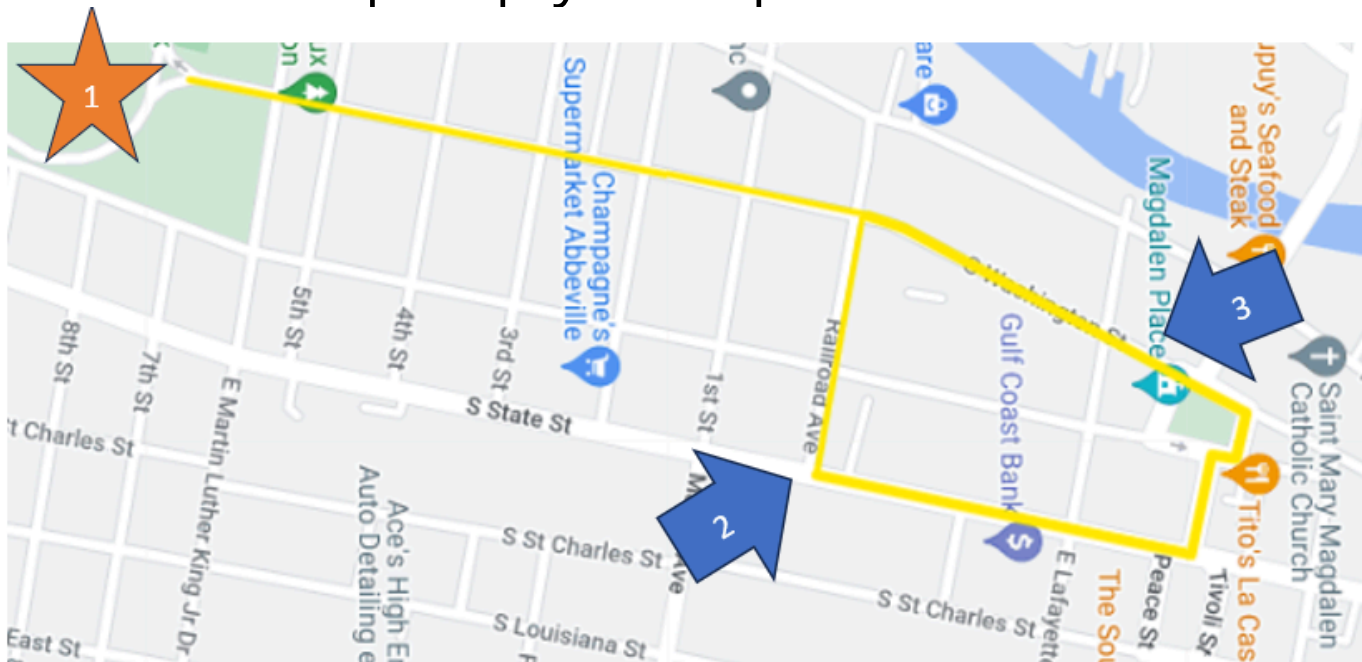




Vermilion Catholic Homecoming Parade Route October 25th | 2:00 Pm

- **ALL FLOATS (TRUCK & TRAILER) CANNOT EXCEED 60 FEET**
 - Every float will be measured - if over 60 feet it will not be allowed to be in parade
 - No 18 wheelers allowed
- All floats, including alumni, please line up starting at 1:15 pm around the Comeaux Park circle
- Line up around Comeaux Park Circle
 - There will be signs showing where your float goes
- Parade starts on State Street promptly at 2:00 pm



1. Floats line up at AA Comeaux Park to **load and unload all riders**
2. Parade begins at State Street - no candy should be thrown until State Street
3. Parade ends – no candy should be thrown after Piazza Office Supply|

Please note that all of these changes and new guidelines are enforced by the city.

FAQ

- How long can the float be?
 - MUST BE 60 FT OR SHORTER
- Who can ride in the parade?
 - Any 6th through 12th grade student
- Who is chaperoning?
 - There will be faculty members and safe environment trained parents on each float
- Where and when do I drop my student off at and pick them up?
 - Comeaux Park starting at 1:15 pm. The parade starts at promptly at 2:00 pm. All floats will go back to Comeaux Park, you can pick up your student there
- What can my child throw in the parade?
 - Candy, beads, and any appropriate parade throws
- What can my child wear?
 - Students should be dressed appropriately to the theme or in VC spirit wear
